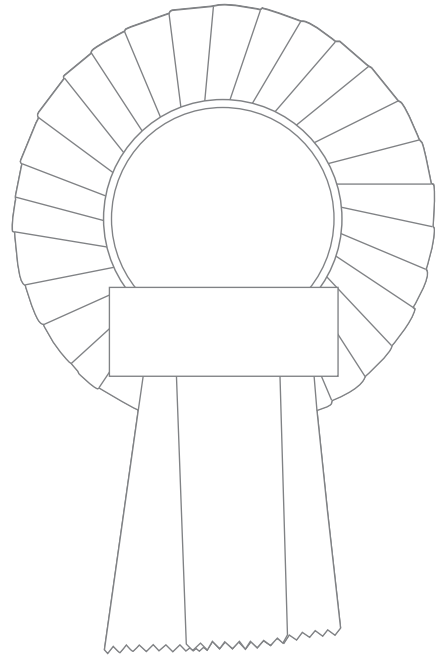


Football fans wear rosettes when they go to football matches.
